Information Sheet

- I. How to get to camp: Bovay Scout Ranch is located three miles south of Navasota on the east side of Highway 6 on County Road 317

Directions thru Hempstead:

- From Hempstead take HWY 6 N for 16 miles
- Turn right onto County Road 317
- Travel to end of the road through camp gate
- Turn right into the Duke Energy Camporee sign just past the Walnut Grove House.

Directions thru Conroe:

- From Conroe take HWY 105 W for 45 miles
- Turn left onto HWY 6 for three miles
- Turn left onto County Road 317 (just past Grassy Creek)
- Travel to end of the road through camp gate
- Turn right into the Duke Energy Camporee sign just past the Walnut Grove House.

- II. Campsites:

- a. Each Patrol will have a separate site (Multiple Patrols within one Pack will be near each other if possible).
- b. Porta-cans available.
- c. Best layout is for tents to line up along one side, tarp in front of the site.
- d. There are no tables in campsites, bring your own table, chairs.
- e. Do not nail, screw or attach anything to the trees.
- f. No fires are allowed in campsites, no liquid fuels (Propane okay).
- g. No campers or other RV's allowed in camp.

- III. Registration Friday, October 26th:

- a. Camp gates open at 6pm.
- b. Drive into entrance, park, and proceed to registration.
- c. **ANY PATROLS WITHOUT PAPERWORK WILL NOT REGISTER.**
- d. Each patrol will be assigned campsite number within designated area.
- e. A stake marker will designate the lower left corner of your site.
- f. Sites will be +/- 50' wide, depending on Patrol size.
- g. **You can drive your car to your site and unload ONLY, move car to parking lot ASAP for traffic flow, then build your campsite.**
- h. Registration available until 11 pm.

- IV. Important Events and Locations:

- a. Staff area and First Aid will be in a central location near the parking lot.
- b. Friday and Saturday night Cracker Barrels are at the Staff area.
- c. Lost and Found is at the Staff Area.
- d. Adult programs are at the Nature Center across the paved road from the Camporee site.
- e. A map of activity areas will be provided at registration.

- f. Water coolers will be located in activity and other areas for your use.
 - g. Bathrooms:
 - i. Scouts will stay out of women's bathrooms.
 - ii. Clean up after yourself. Violators will do clean up duty!
 - iii. Supplies (TP and soap) will be available.
 - iv. We anticipate 600 - 800 campers; this is not a play area.
- V. Entering and Exiting Camp:
- a. Gates will be closed from 11:00 pm to 6:00 am Friday and Saturday.
 - b. **IF YOU LEAVE CAMP, TELL A STAFF MEMBER.**
- VI. Sunday morning checkout:
- a. A boy scout is reverent, so we encourage your patrol attend the Sunday morning flag and church service.
 - b. No one leaves the camp until it has been inspected by Staff.
 - c. Trash cleanup includes the road areas near your campsite.
 - d. Assign one adult to request inspection by staff.
 - e. Package (patches, etc.) given to adult after site approved.
 - f. Dumpsters are on the main road on the way out of camp.
 - g. Camp will close and everyone will be gone by 11:00 am.

GADGETS

Gadgets that the boys have made to enhance their campsite are GREAT! These may be necessary for the competition in the fall. If you have gadgets we will "inspect" them and give you feedback:

Notes:

1. **SHAC prohibits liquid fuels**, propane use only. Open fires will not be allowed in campsites. Grease must go into a can or other safe container and be packed out with the litter. Camp Bovay is a "Leave no Trace" area.
2. **All litter must be carried out when you leave.** All gear not in use must be properly stored.
3. Tent and tarp guy lines should be marked with flagging or not accessible to others walking by; tents and tarps should not be near fire rings or combustibles; in general – Does any condition in the campsite pose a hazard to Scouts or others?
4. Woods tools are not appropriate at this location. Clothes lines should not cross paths
5. If a Pack chooses to "line" or "border" their campsite, it must NOT pose a tripping hazard. Borders must either lay FLAT on the ground or be properly staked and marked (same method as marking tent lines) If you are not sure about this requirement, get verification from the Director or Campmaster.
6. **NO ADULTS** should be in the campsite during designated inspection timeframes. If there is an adult in the campsite, the campsite will not be inspected and this will be noted on the form and the form turned in not inspected. An Adult Program is available or adults are encouraged to sign up to assist in the Activity program.
7. Grade sheets will be returned in the Pack Checkout Packet.
